



### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Prepare & Measure:** Determine how much of The Old Farmer's Almanac Tomato & Vegetable Plant Food you need using the Application Guide below.

**Spread Evenly & Mix In:** Spread plant food evenly, and mix it gently into the soil, ensuring you do not damage existing plants. Do not allow granules to gather in piles on the ground, or sit on leaves or flowers.

**Water After Application:** To activate plant food, water plants after application until the soil is moist, but not over-saturated. Water at the base of the plant so water doesn't gather on leaves or foliage.

**Apply Regularly:** For best results apply plant food to your garden every 6-8 weeks during the growing season.

### APPLICATION GUIDE

**For Potted Plants:** At the beginning of the growing season, or when first planting, mix 1.5 Tablespoons of plant food gently into the soil for every 12 Inches of pot diameter. After initial feed, gently mix plant food into topsoil every 6-8 weeks or as needed.

**Planting Beds:** When planting, spread 2/3 Cup of plant food evenly per 25 Square Feet of excavated soil; and mix in to a depth of 5-8 Inches. After the initial feed, gently mix plant food into topsoil every 6-8 weeks or as needed.

**Trees & Shrubs:** For new plants, mix 1/4 Cup of fertilizer into every 6 Square Feet of soil used to fill the hole. For established plants, spread 1 Cup of fertilizer for every 25 Square Feet of branch spread ensuring fertilizer is spread under, and slightly beyond, the branch span. After the initial feed, gently mix plant food into the topsoil every 6-8 weeks or as needed throughout the growing season.

### INSTRUCCIONES DE USO

**Preparar y medir:** Determine cuánto alimento para plantas necesita utilizando la Guía de aplicación a continuación.

**Extender uniformemente y mezclar:** Distribuya Plant Food de manera uniforme y mezcle suavemente en el suelo, asegurándose de no dañar las plantas existentes. No permita que el fertilizante se acumule en montones o se asiente sobre hojas o flores.

**Agua después de la aplicación:** Para activar el alimento para plantas, riegue las plantas después de la aplicación hasta que el suelo esté húmedo, pero no demasiado saturado. Agua en la base de la planta.

**Apply Regularly:** Para obtener los mejores resultados, aplique cada 6 a 8 semanas durante la temporada de crecimiento.

### GUIA DE APLICACION

**Para plantas en maceta:** Cuando plante por primera vez, mezcle 1.5 cucharadas de alimento para plantas suavemente en el suelo por cada 12 pulgadas de diámetro de la maceta. Después de la alimentación inicial, mezcle suavemente el alimento para plantas en la tierra vegetal cada 6-8 semanas o según sea necesario.

**Camas de siembra:** Al plantar, distribuya 2/3 tazas de alimento para plantas de manera uniforme por cada 25 pies cuadrados de suelo excavado; y mezcle hasta una profundidad de 5-8 pulgadas. Después de la alimentación inicial, mezcle suavemente los alimentos para plantas en la tierra vegetal según sea necesario.

**Árboles y arbustos:** Para plantas nuevas, mezcle 1/4 de taza en cada 6 pies cuadrados de tierra utilizada para llenar el hoyo. Para plantas establecidas, esparza 1 taza por cada 25 pies cuadrados de extensión de ramas, asegurándose de que el fertilizante se esparza por debajo y un poco más allá de la extensión de las ramas. Repita según sea necesario durante la temporada de crecimiento.
